Process in Parliament

Mid May- July Parliament Process:

- - 12th of May rapporteur Beer (Renew) presents draft report:
Amendments by end of 25th of May via allies in parliament

 - Mohamed Chahim (S&D, NL)
 - Henrike Hahn (Greens, DE)
 - Cornelia Ernst (Left, DE)
 - Hildegaard Bentele (EPP, DE)

Process Parliament

- Parallel: INTA, Deve, Droi
- June-July: Plenary Session on CRMA
- *(Amendments drafting - propose amendments, seek allies, build arguments for respective parties)*
- August: Summer Recess

Trialogues

Process in Council

- Member states form their position and meet several times within the council
- Concerns can also be raised via EU-Member states governments
- Council often more conservative

Dialogues

- September-Oct-Nov: Dialogues
- Dec-Jan: Vote on the CRMA

Possibilities to intervene

- Consultation
- Input in Open letter -> collecting supporters for open letter
- Raise concerns to us or directly MEPs
- Ideas for concrete Amendments
- Most effectively concerns to be raised until end of April -> 20th of May
